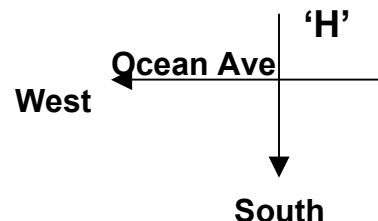



Membership Report:

I hope everyone enjoyed the holiday break. I'd like to thank all those members who have renewed their membership. Your commitment to renew on time is greatly appreciated. For all those who have not renewed their membership, please do so immediately. If not done by the end of January, Legion service years will be reset to zero. Below, you see a breakdown of our membership due to renew. Think about what YOUR post is losing if you don't renew.

There are 87 members with 1–10 legion years who have not renewed. This adds up to 293 years of legion experience.

There are 35 members with 11–20 legion years who have not renewed. This adds up to 536 years of legion experience.

There are 21 members with 21–30 legion years who have not renewed. This adds up to 527 years of legion experience.

There are 6 members with 31 or more legion years who have not renewed. This adds up to 194 years of legion experience.
